Jen and Ryan Wale, and Melissa, Jack and Kate Van Mastrigt. Mike Beale was our guest.

The President welcomed members and our guest, Mike Beale. Mike has recently moved to Wake Forest and has a new Weimaraner puppy. He has been a member of the Chattahoochee Weimaraner Club in Atlanta. The President announced that the Club will participate in the Raleigh Christmas Parade, in the AKC section, on Saturday, Nov. 19, 2016. Volunteers are needed to march with their Weims and carrying the banner. Participation in this event fulfills an AKC educational requirement we must have to qualify for holding our Specialty Show.
