On test day, our handler/dog teams, three with Weimaraners and one with a Golden Retriever, put in great effort and produced two TD titles. The first TD title went to CH Regen's Lucky Draw AX, AXJ, TK1, DJ, call name "Maverick" (Weimaraner) handled by Wanda Gunter. The second title went to CH Bivins Sandolar Through The Looking Glass RA, call name "Alice" (Weimaraner) handled by Anne McPherson. It was exciting to witness these teams win their titles.
