For the months of February, March, and April 2018, we accepted 17 dogs, and placed 15 in their forever homes. Sadly during this time we lost two dogs, and one of which was a 14 year old in a permanent foster home.

Congratulations:

You have been following the success stories of **Dr. Rita McGinnis** and her rescue girl **Doozie (Doozie Dazzles Daily CD, BN, PCD, RM, JH, CGC)**. On April 1, 2018 Doozie received her Rally Master title with a perfect score of 100. Only one other Weim in the country has a Rally Master. In addition, she also received the "Achiever Dog" certificate from AKC which was awarded to her for having successfully competed in 3 different AKC sports (Obedience, Rally, and Hunting). We are pleased to announce the birth of another future rescue volunteer, Harbor Gray Wulff, born on February 5th. Congratulations to **Laura & Conny Wulff!**

Collaboration with Our Sister Weim Rescues:

We are very fortunate to have such a great working relationship with our sister Weim rescues. A wonderful example of that was in March when we accepted two owner surrenders from South Georgia at the request of the **Atlanta Weimaraner Club Rescue**. Both GA and SC groups helped make arrangements to move them from the Savannah area to the Wilmington area. **Elena Lamberson** graciously agreed to board them for a few days on their way to us. She even took care of getting all the paperwork from the surrendering owner for us. All of this took place on a Sunday afternoon! And then one of her kennel workers transported them to Wilmington later that week. Thank you so much **Elena** (and your kennel staff) and **Billie Nagorniak** from SC for all your help!

Two more recent examples of cooperation with our sister rescues involved two home visits completed at the request of other Weim rescues: Long time TWC members and TWR volunteers **Kathi and Joe Stringer** and **Debbie and Joe Moody** did home visits on applicants for **Weimaraner Rescue of the South** and **Atlanta Weimaraner Club Rescue**. Thanks Kathi, Joe, Debbie, and Joe – you did TWC and TWR proud!

And finally, we are once again working with **Senior Moments Weim Rescue** on a 12 year old female. Sweet **Riley** has visual and hearing problems, ear problems, allergies, infections in one of her legs (apparently from some of the hardware from previous surgery), and doesn't like to be around other dogs. Senior Moments found a perfect permanent foster home for her, arranged for transportation to that foster, and we are working together on managing Riley's ongoing needs. Thank you **Laurie Collins** and your amazing network of volunteers with **Senior Moments!**

Rescue Stories:

During this three-month period, five dogs age 8 and older found permanent homes. That includes one age 10, one age 11, and one age 12, and we continue to be blessed with adopters willing to bring seniors into their families. Hopefully we can update you on some of them in future editions of the newsletter.

Georgia

Georgia came to us from a shelter in October 2017. She was approximately 5 years old, was picked up as a stray, and was heartworm positive. She was in a wonderful foster home while undergoing HW treatment, and a great adopter was ready when she was ready for adoption. Please enjoy some of her new Dad's comments below.



"Georgia is doing great...She is very happy and seems to understand that this is her permanent home and that she is not going anywhere. So we are now seeing her full personality. Every day is full of laughs and adventure...She also no longer seems to be food driven. She takes her time eating and if something distracts her, she investigates and then returns to eating. Of course, this does not mean that she is not first in line for a treat.

Georgia just got back from her first road trip when we drove to New Mexico to pick up our daughter from graduate school. She visited Virginia, Tennessee, Arkansas, Oklahoma, Texas, and New Mexico. She loved the trip and travels very well. Unlike Bella, who likes to stand so that she can stare for hours out the front window and drool on my wife and I, Georgia likes to sit on the passenger side of the back seat and look out the rear and side windows. When not looking out the window she likes to sleep curled up in a circle on the seat or floor. She is also a good sport. When Bella decides to lay down, she always put her bottom on Georgia.

The two of them are so jealous. They each believe that they alone are entitled to all our love. Bella, who weighs a little more, likes to use the 'subtle block' to make sure that she is the sole recipient of the petting. Georgia uses her smaller size and speed to get there first or squeeze between the 'petter' and Bella. Still, they get along great and will defend each other. In April our daughter was home for a few days with her two dogs, and Bella felt one was being too aggressive to Georgia. So she jumped between them and let Alice know that that was unacceptable. One day while I was walking them at work (they like to come to work with me and everyone here enjoys it when they do), we were walking down a very narrow path when a large husky comes running up the path towards us. When he was next to Bella, Georgia barked and leaped at him/her. Scared him/her so much they jumped into the bushes and ran off.

My wife is also jealous. She tells people, "Chuck leaves for work and they stare at the door, I feed them breakfast, drive them to a beautiful area for a long walk, cuddle with them on the couch, have them outside with me when I work in the yard, and feed them dinner. When Chuck comes home they go crazy, Georgia jumps all over him, and everything is right with the world now that their favorite human is home." Georgia likes to sleep on the pillows across the top of the bed with her head and paw on me. When Bella, or one of our daughter's dogs, come over to me you should see the look on Georgia's face - if looks could kill! If that is not enough, she pulls herself up on me so that her entire upper body is completely covering my face and chest.

One day...I was in the house and my wife started banging on the window from the outside, yelling emergency. I ran out and Georgia had blood on her snout, nostril, and ear. Took her inside and treated her. We thought she stuck her head in one of the rose bushes. Unfortunately, a little later, Jocelyn found a dead squirrel. Although dead, the squirrel did not have any visible injuries and there was not any blood. We think it scratched Georgia and maybe died of fright or a heart attack. She must have caught it and was bringing it to my wife. She is fascinated by squirrels. She will spend hours staring out the French door overlooking the back yard just watching the squirrels. When she is outside, she walks around with her head looking straight up following the squirrels in the trees. Last fall Jocelyn and I were in the drive through at Starbucks. The young woman asked us if we would like a 'puppy whip' for Bella who was in the back seat...She was instantly addicted. So now, Georgia is addicted to them also...Even if the dogs are not with us, we cannot go to Starbucks without bringing home a 'puppy whip' for each of them. They seem to recognize the logo and cups so we cannot fool them."
