Happy Spring Everyone!

For the months of February, March, and April 2019, TWR took in 32 dogs. That included 12 dogs on the same day in February – three young adults and two litters of puppies. During the same period of time, we placed 25 dogs in their new homes. But sadly, we lost one of our long time permanent foster girls, Riesling.

SPECIAL INTAKE SUCCESS STORY:

We were contacted by a breeder in Eastern NC that had too many dogs per Animal Control, and they told him he needed to find homes for most of them immediately. Fortunately he was willing to sign many of them over to us. TWR board member, **Toni Sweetland** and her husband **Scott**, headed east very early the next morning. Since the breeder was also trying to find homes for his dogs, we didn't know how many they would be able to get. But they were prepared for all of them with crates, collars, leashes, etc.

We were able to get three young adults, four 10 week old puppies, and five 4 week old puppies. All three adults were 14 month old litter mates, and one of them was the mother of the younger pups. Once everyone was loaded up, Toni and Scott headed to Northwoods Animal Hospital in Cary where we were going to have two of the adults vetted and boarded. **Catina Rhinehart** (another board member) met them there to take the four older pups to be boarded over the weekend. Then Toni and Scott stopped by their home to pack a quick change of clothes, and headed to Rutherfordton where President **Kathy LeCavalier** was going to foster the younger pups and their mom. Toni and Scott got the pups and their mom to Rutherfordton late that night, and Kathy got them settled for the night. As soon as they returned to the Triangle the following day, Toni picked up the four older pups to foster. The three adult dogs had not been socialized, wouldn't walk on the leash, barked at everything, and had to be carried into the vets' office, a home, etc. The Mama dog was even worse since she was also protecting her pups. Fortunately, all of the adults responded to the loving care and training they received by special vet techs, Toni and Scott, Kathy L., and their foster homes. By the time they were adopted, they weren't even the same dogs we picked up from the breeder. All nine puppies and the three adults found wonderful homes, and are living the good life. We hope to have happy reports in future newsletters.

Riesling was 12 years old when she came to us in August of 2017 with her 11 year old brother **Jager**. She first went into day care/boarding, but in October she moved to one of our new foster homes. This turned out to be a wonderful home for Riesling and for TWR.

Unfortunately, Riesling required a tremendous amount of work for her foster family due to her urinary incontinence. No matter what they tried, medically and supportively, the best they got was some minor improvement. And this, of course, required many extra loads of laundry, lots of floor cleaning, and precautions for Riesling throughout the house. But this fabulous family said they would give her a loving home for as long as she lived. And they went above and beyond in fulfilling that promise for giving Riesling a good life.



A couple of months after they took Riesling, her foster mom was placed on bedrest for a high risk pregnancy. And a month later she gave birth to a preemie, but they never even considered sending Riesling to another foster home. They made it clear that they would do everything they could for Riesling, and would give her a loving and supportive home until she was ready to say goodbye to us. And when the foster parents knew it was time, they filled her last few days with everything they could to make Riesling happy. They took her for a ride, fed her all her favorite things, kept her comfortable,

and even painted her toenails to match her foster mom's. On her last day, she spent some time in the sun, barked and smiled at their other Weim, "ate some grass, munched on some mulch, chased a bug, and thought about eating a stick." She had a great time and then she was exhausted, and promptly went to her favorite spot on the couch to rest.

She crossed over the Rainbow Bridge with lovely red and gold glitter nails and wearing her best bandana that matched her nails. RIP Riesling. And we can never thank **Sage** and **Michael** enough for totally altering their lives for a year and a half to accommodate sweet Riesling's needs and giving her a wonderful life.
