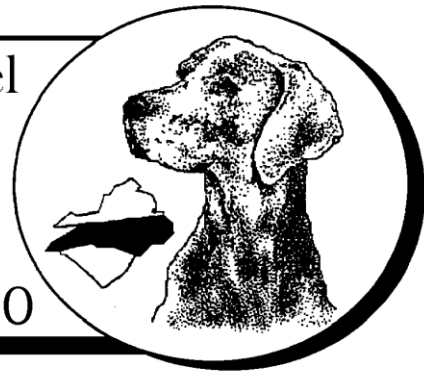

## **Rescue Report:**

It's time once again to give you a quick update on our busy Weim Rescue. We have 16 dogs on the website currently, more coming in daily, and adopted out approximately 18 during June and July. It's a moving target and changes every day, some are in foster homes with the "option to adopt", other adoptions are currently in the works and not quite finalized. Suffice it to say that we are "filled" with dogs and still trying to find loving homes for several of the puppy mill Weims.

Below are two of our recent success stories:

- 1) Letter from **Fiona's** new "parents" – she was one of the puppy mill dogs who is finally learning about warm beds and loving humans:

*I have always admired Weimaraners for their beauty and grace but I have had Burmese cats all my life and was reluctant to own a Weim as some show aggression towards small furry animals. My husband has always had Labs and when our oldest approached ten years old we thought a puppy would be good for her so last year we got a chocolate female. Our oldest unexpectedly died three months later.*

*Our house was on the market so we did not want to take on another four legged creature. When it sold a month ago, it became increasingly evident that Sushi (chocolate lab now one year old) needed a companion. We did not want to go through puppyhood again and thought an older dog would be a good fit for Sushi as we had one when she arrived. I also revisited my desire to have a Weimaraner and decided that an older rescue dog would have an established personality and disposition towards other animals. I then found Tarheel Weimaraner Rescue on line and Fiona.*

*We took a leap of faith and are so glad we did. Fiona is sweet, endearing and very gentle. She shows no interest in the cats and even seems a bit timid around them. Fiona and Sushi are fast friends and enjoy long walks with us. We feel blessed that we are able to give her the happy life she deserves!*

- 2) Another of our recent successes is dear, sweet **Zeus!** He is eight years old and came to us with "fatty tumors", very underweight and heartworm positive. His owner had passed away and the family called us because they could not keep Zeus. He was in Rescue for 7 months and his prayers were finally answered. He is now in a home and nestled in bed with his new mom and dad.

We are grateful for your assistance, donations and kind thoughts. If you have a little extra time and would like to help with transport, we are always in need of folks to transport dogs from shelters to foster homes or from foster homes to permanent homes. ## Weim and Cheese Fundraising Event!

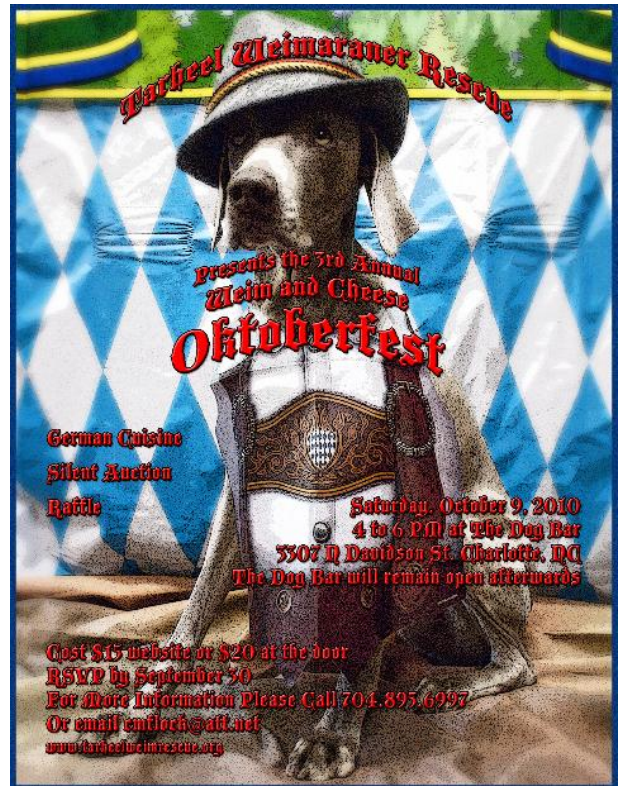

# Retrieving and Hunting Supplies

Are you working on retrieving for our October Retrieving Ratings, or hunting for our November Shooting Ratings and/or February Hunt Tests? Do you know what kind of equipment that you will need?

For NRD training, you might want to have several canvas or plastic bumpers, a check cord, and blanks and a blank gun. For advanced training, you might also want field poppers for your 12 gauge, a retriever launcher, and an e-training collar.

For NSD and JH training, you might want to have things like blanks and a blank gun, an orange hunting vest w/ bird bag, an Acme Thunderer whistle on a lanyard, and a check cord. For advanced training, you also might want to have a TBI Game Stewards bird bag, a quail carrying crate, a reversible orange/yellow collar, an e-training collar and a remote bird launcher.
